

- 1. The Provisional Certificate of Approval is hereby amended to reflect the reorganization of the Ontario Ministry of Environment and Energy as the Ontario Ministry of the Environment and shall be read with all the necessary changes.
- 2. The Provisional Certificate of Approval is amended by adding the following conditions:

  - 87.3 The Director shall allow at least 30 days under Condition 87.2 unless that 30 day period will not allow at least an additional 60 days before the termination of the financial assurance becomes effective.
  - 87.4 When financial assurance is presented in documentary form and the documentary form provides for a deductable or for premiums the Company shall provide additional financial assurance in the form of cash or an irrevocable letter of credit in an amount equal to at least the sum of the deductable and one year's premiums. The irrevocable letter of credit may require the Diroctor to certify that the money is required to satisfy a claim for a deductable or to pay premiums for the documentary financial assurance.

  - (1) For the purpose of Condition 92, "sufficient funds" means as a minimum, the costs associated with the closure, monitoring and maintenance of the Taro West Quarry Landfill as required by Provisional Certificate of Approval number A 130404 and as outlined in the document titled "Taro West Quarry Landfill, Financial Assurance Proposal, March 6, 1997" submitted by the Company.
  - (2) Condition 92 becomes null and void in its entirety upon submission of financial assurance in a form and amount acceptable to the Director that provides for sufficient funds for the closure, monitoring and maintenance of the Taro West Quarry Landfill, in accordance with its Provisional Certificate of Approval number A 130404.

The reason for the addition of Condition 92 is as follows:

1. The Site and the West Quarry Landfill Site share some common physical features such as drainage and leachate control and installations for the monitoring of surface water and ground water, so that the facilities at the West Quarry Landfill Site must be completed and maintained properly in conjunction with facilities at the Landfill Site to ensure the proper control of drainage and leachate at each. The plan by the Company for its West Quarry Landfill Site provides for the completion of work at the West Quarry Landfill Site to be funded by revenue from the Site and that this revenue will act as Financial
