This letter is further to my e-mail to you of May 6, 2002, enclosing an electronic copy of the Hydromantis Report attached to this letter (although the Appendices were not ready at that time). Please note that the complete report is now available electronically on the City of Hamilton's website (www.city.hamilton.on.ca).

As you are aware, Condition 96 of the Amendment to the above-noted Provisional Certificate for Approval No. A181008, as issued to Philip Services Inc., states as follows:

The Company shall not discharge any leachate from the Taro East Landfill Site for the Woodward Avenue Waste Water Treatment Plant WWTP until an evaluation of the impact of the combined Taro West and East Landfill leachates on the Woodward Avenue WWTP through experimental wastewater treatment pilot plant tests together with scans of metals and trace organics removal and accumulation in biosolids, as recommended in the Final Report, Taro East Landfill, Expert Panel, dated October 2000 has been carried out and these pilot plant tests show the discharge of leachate from the Taro West and East Landfill leachate to the Woodward Avenue WWTP is acceptable to the City of Hamilton.

The City of Hamilton retained Hydromantis Inc. ("Hydromantis") to conduct the pilot plant tests set out in Condition No. 96 above. Please find enclosed an originally signed copy of the Hydromantis Report entitled "Biotreatability Study to Assess Impacts of the Combined Taro East and West Landfill Leachate on the Woodward Avenue WWTP" and dated May, 2002. The report recommends in part that "the discharge of TEL (Taro East Landfill) leachate through the forcemain from the landfill site to the City of Hamilton's sanitary sewer for ultimate treatment through the Woodward Avenue WWTP be approved. The discharge of leachate from the Taro West and East Landfill to the Woodward Avenue WWTP represents an appropriate treatment and disposal alternative that we recommend be accepted by the City of Hamilton." (words in italics added by way of explanation). These recommendations are acceptable to the City of Hamilton.

For your additional reference, please find enclosed a copy of a Report dated April 29, 2002 from Mr. Garry Palmateer of GAP EnviroMicrobial Services respecting his review of the sampling protocols and laboratory analysis undertaken by Hydromantis and the two laboratories used by Hydromantis during the course of the pilot plant tests.

Kindly advise me in writing upon your office's approval or clearance of all conditions under Provisional Certificate of Approval No. A181008, as amended, relating to the discharge of leachate from the Taro East Landfill Site to the City of Hamilton's sanitary sewer system, including but not limited to Conditions 95 and 96 of the above noted Provisional Certificate of Approval, so that the City of Hamilton is aware of when the leachate forcemain can be used.

The Corporations Information Act states that every extra-provincial corporation, other than a corporation of a class exempted by the Regulations, that begins to carry on business in Ontario shall file an Initial Return, Form 2, within sixty (60) days after the date the corporation begins to carry on business in Ontario. The Initial Return you have just filed has generated an Ontario Corporation Number and created a file for the public record for your corporation.

#### Notice of Change

In addition to the Initial Return you have recently filed, you are required to file a Notice of Change for every change in the information within 15 days after the change or changes take place. There is no fee for filing these notices.

#### Forms

Forms may be obtained from the Ministry at the above noted address or by <u>calling (416) 314-8880, 1-800-361-3223 or TDD (416) 212-1476</u>. Forms are also available on the Ministry's website at <u>www.cbs.gov.on.ca</u>. To access the forms, select the 'Business Information' option at the top of the Ministry's home page.

#### **Business Name**

- (a) No corporation shall carry on business in Ontario or identify itself to the public in Ontario by a name other than its corporation name unless the name is first registered. The appropriate registration form may be obtained from the Companies and Personal Property Security Branch or by calling one of the above noted telephone numbers.
- (b) A corporation which has registered and uses a name other than its corporate name is required to set out its corporate name and all registered business names on all contracts, invoices, negotiable instruments and orders for goods or services.

#### Penalties

Sections 13 and 14 of the Corporations Information Act provide penalties for contravening the Act or Regulations.

Section 18(1) of the Act provides that a corporation that is in default of a requirement under this Act to file a notice or that has unpaid fees or penalties is not capable of maintaining a proceeding in a court in Ontario in respect of the business carried on by the corporation except with leave of the court.
